

Put together a Market Day toolbox to keep on hand. By having all the below listed items in one location it will save time in preparing your displays. Little dramas like fly away signage, signage falling will be easily fixed while preparing your trestle table cloth, etc, etc.

Market Day Tool Kit

First thing. Your tool kit is some type of box, bag, small plastic tote, or even a fishing box. I highly recommend your tool kit should have a lid and maybe a lock so items won't go missing. (from experiences) Place your name and market stall name on your tool kit just in case it goes missing or you leave it behind.

Staple Gun: You can purchase this from Bunnings or your \$2 shops, it's up to you how much you want to spend.

Staples: For your Staple gun.

Fishing Line: Is great to have just in case you needed to hang up some extra signage.

Small Hole Puncher: To put holes in your signage to hang.

Hammer and screwdrivers: A small tack hammer should do, you never know when you need one.

Nails and screws (assorted)

Notepad, Pens, Markers: To take down notes throughout the day, markers to change hand written signs end of day specials.

Paperweights: Perfect for those windy days, your business cards and brochures want end up at the other end of the market.

Double Sided Tape.

Masking tape: If you have a hire table maybe its not a good idea to put holes in it with a staple gun. So first place masking tape along the edges of the table then on your table cloth use your double sided tape. Stick the double side tape with cloth on the masking tape. It's so much easier to remove the double side tape this way. And won't leave marks.

A packet of wet wipes: Sometimes it's hard to get to a tap of water so keep a packet of wet wipes to keep your hands nice and clean and if there is any spills or unwanted marks on your products.

Scissors.

Tape measure.

Stanley knife.

Velcro strips: Another way to attach your cloth to the table or any signage.

A large piece of clear plastic: To place over your tables just in case its rains, make sure it is clear so people can still view your products while it's raining.

DON'T FORGET TO BRING A CAMERA TO TAKE PHOTOS OF YOUR WONDERFUL MARKET STALL to remind you of the next market...

REMEMBER DON'T LEAVE HOME WITHOUT IT! That is your tool kit.
